

PhD Supervision at ANU

There are two central eligibility requirements before one can submit an application for admission into ANU's PhD program. They are detailed [here](#).

If you wish to make an inquiry regarding my potential availability to be your supervisor, email me with the following information.

1. A copy of your CV which includes specifics as to what university courses you have taken (highlighting any courses in economics, statistics/econometrics, psychology, international relations or political science) and what level Honours you graduated; and
2. A thesis/dissertation proposal, of no more than 2 pages, describing:
 - a. The phenomenon of international politics you wish to study. What 'outcomes' interest you? I'm less interested in your thoughts on causes of these outcomes, but rather why you think the outcomes themselves are puzzling or worthy of study.
 - b. Why you are particularly suited to studying these phenomena/outcomes. What do you offer that the average candidate might not?
 - c. Why you wish to study a PhD, and what you would like to do with the degree following graduation.

The most serious proposals will exhibit an awareness of the challenges of research design and the types of methods you wish to use. This [book](#) and this [article](#) are useful introductions, as is this [document](#).
